

Choice Scholarships provide State funding to qualifying students that can be used to offset tuition costs at participating Choice schools. Each individual student (not family) must qualify based on the following eligibility requirements:

- 1. Student must have legal settlement in Indiana;
- 2. Student must be at least 5 years old
- 3. Student is a member of a household with an annual income of not more than 400% of the amount to qualify for the Federal Reduced Lunch Program

Income Guidelines

The Household Adjusted Gross Income is used to determine income eligibility. A student may be eligible for a "90% scholarship. This is not 90% Holy Redeemer's tuition, but 90% of what the public school is allocated by the state of Indiana per student if the student attended their public school. (90% of EVSC's student rate was \$6,443.58 for the 2022-2023 school year.)

Tuition Costs for "90%" Scholarship

Tuition amounts may vary depending on being an active parishioner at Holy Redeemer Church, non-active parishioner or a non-parishioner. **These costs are based upon <u>EVSC</u> figures from 2022-2023. The charts below are the breakdown of tuition costs for the 2023-2024 school year at Holy Redeemer School <u>if your child meets one of the pathways and meets the financial requirements.</u> (The amounts are based off of the EVSC school district rates. Other school districts will vary slightly.)
